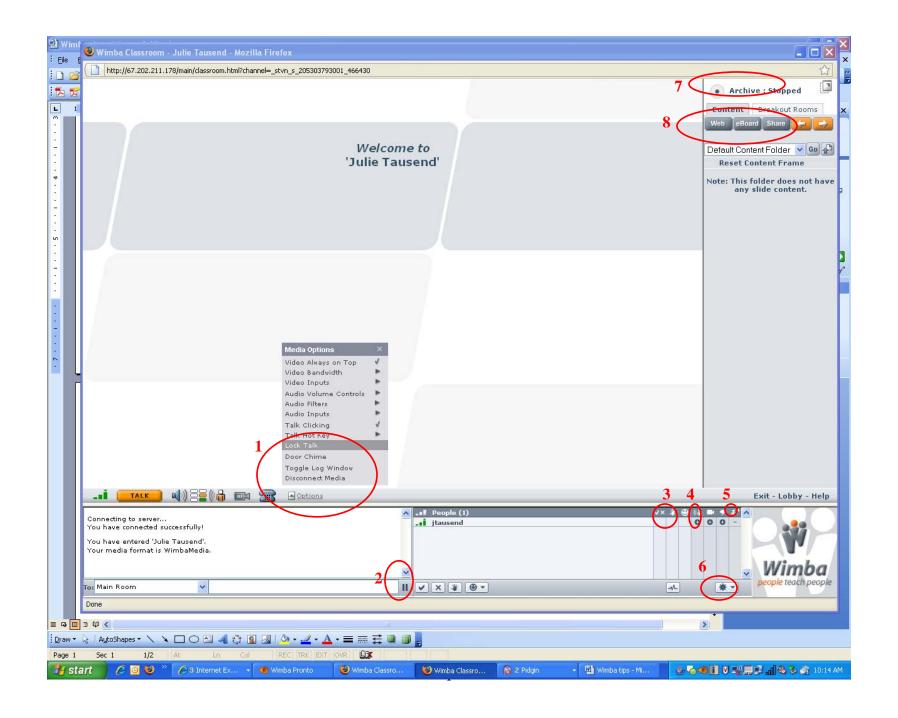
Wimba Interface Quick Guide Several key features of the Wimba Interface are noted below. A brief description of each, with corresponding number, is listed on page two For additional information, visit www.stevens.edu/itwiki/wimba and www.stevens.edu/itwiki/pronto



- 1.) Lock Talk (prevents instructor from needing to press "Talk" Button or hold Ctrl key for entire presentation)
 - a. Click Options
 - b. Select Lock Talk
 - *Students will need to either click and hold the "Talk" Button or hold Ctrl key.
- 2.) Pause Chat (stops you from seeing the chat, even though chat continues to take place)
 - a. Clicking the Pause button will pause the chat
 - b. Clicking the Play button will enable the chat again
- 3.) Raised Hand Indicator (indicates the order students raised their hands)
- 4.) Mute Students
 - a. Click the plus sign to mute students
 - b. Click the minus sign to unmute
- 5.) Presenter Rights
 - a. Click the plus sign to give students presenter rights
 - b. Click the minus sign to take away presenter rights
 - *This does not take presenter rights away from you
 - *More than one person can have presenter rights
- 6.) Settings (click to access:)
 - a. Disable Chat
 - b. Clear Yes/No
 - c. Clear Raised Hands
 - d. Other settings
- 7.) Archive (records the presentation and audio)
 - a. Click the circle to start
 - b. Must click the same circle to stop the archive
 - *The archive will save automatically once stopped
- 8.) Web, eboard, Share
 - a. Show a webpage with students
 - b. Use White board tools
 - c. Application Share
